

LOCAL EXHAUST VENTILATION EQUIPMENT

PURPOSE

To ensure local exhaust ventilation equipment is designed and installed in accordance with standards and recommended practices for the control of hazardous materials.

GUIDELINES

- A. Local exhaust ventilation equipment includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- Laboratory fume hoods
 - Dust collectors
 - Biological safety cabinets
 - Welding hoods
 - Canopy hoods
 - Electrostatic
 - Bench hoods
 - Precipitators
 - Downdraft hoods
 - Scrubbers
 - Slot hoods
 - Other local exhaust equipment
- B. All construction plans and/or requisitions for new local exhaust ventilation equipment shall be made available to the Department of Environmental Health and Safety and Facilities Management for review.
- C. All material modifications to existing local exhaust ventilation equipment shall require the review of the Director, Department of Environmental Health and Safety and Facilities Management.
- D. Department of Environmental Health and Safety approval of plans for modifications to local exhaust ventilation equipment shall be based on standards and recommended practices for the control of hazardous materials.
- E. The Facilities Management Department shall ensure that the local exhaust ventilation equipment is installed in accordance with the approved plan.
