- Continue Excellent Chemical Hygiene Practices






New EHS Chemical Inventory Program

EHS Inventory System






New System Features


- The New EH&S Inventory system will replace the EHS Assistant
- The start date of the new system is August 16, 2021. (do not use EHS Assistant)
- All data from EHS Assistant will be automatically uploaded into new system.
- The new system allows the PI and/or Lab Manager to add lab users and assign roles.
- New system features include the ability to add, delete and modify chemicals.
- New system will have in-house support from our FIU IT department.
- Web based, not VPN access needed.











Start with new request-






Required info to add a chemical






Storage Locations








