 **251** Total Submissions

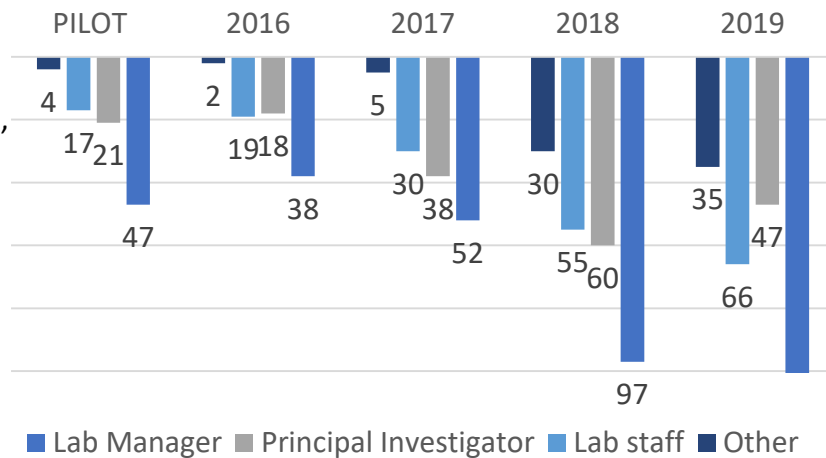
### Annual Participation Analysis By Role

 **3.7 %** Increase in Participation

Through the years, Laboratory Managers have participated the most; from 2018 to 2019, there was an:


 **6.2 %** Increase in Lab Manager Participation
